Dear Storage Participant:

Please note the following dates have been designated for the 2018/2019 vehicle storage season:

Saturday, November 3, 2018

8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

Saturday, November 10, 2018

8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

The entrance to the grounds will be, as in the past, from the Ironwood Road Gate #1. PLEASE REPORT TO THE FAIR OPERATIONS OFFICE BEFORE PARKING YOUR VEHICLE. The storage program is on a first come basis. Please know that there will be an additional outside storage fee of \$10.00 per day, per vehicle, for any vehicle(s) not removed by March 23, 2019. The buildings are equipped with fire and theft protection, but are not heated.

There will be one Saturday for removal, which will be Saturday, March 23, 2019, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and Noon. If you were one of the last vehicles parked in a particular building, you must be here promptly on March 23 because until you remove your vehicle, no other vehicles will be able to move out.

When you bring your vehicle for storage, you will be asked to provide the license plate number for the vehicle you are leaving for storage (for identification purposes). Please have this ready when you come to the office. For your convenience, we have enclosed a release form you can complete prior to your arrival. This should help alleviate waiting in a lengthy line. Additional forms can also be found on our web site at [www.4hfair.com](http://www.4hfair.com). If you are not a member of 4-H Fair, Inc., you will be asked for a \$2.00 membership fee which is good for a 5 year period.

Fees for the 2018-2019 season remain the same as last year and are set out on the enclosed page. These rates are determined by the TOTAL LENGTH, including tongue or other projections.


**NOTE: YOU MUST BRING YOUR OWN TOOLS AND COME PREPARED TO DISCONNECT AND/OR REMOVE YOUR BATTERY/BATTERIES.**

We have discovered in the past that Saturdays are not always good days to schedule storage for some people. Therefore, our early storage procedure for 2018/2019 season is as follows:

- For an additional \$25.00 per vehicle, over and above the storage rate, you will be permitted, with an appointment, to bring your car to the Fairgrounds between 1:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m., any weekday starting September 24.
- Boats, pontoons, motorhomes, campers, etc. will be permitted early storage for an additional \$25.00 during the week of October 29. Call beginning October 15 for an appointment.

This means, for an additional \$25.00 plus a phone call to let us know when you are coming, you can avoid having to wait in line on either Saturday. If you have any questions, please feel free to call 574-291-4870.
